#### **FRIENDS AT HOME**

FRIENDS AT HOME is the core of our program. Each week, pairs of teenage volunteers visit participating children in the environment they are most comfortable in, their own homes.

These teens are specially trained for their valuable role as a friend and mentor.



#### **HOLIDAY PROGRAMS**

Friendship Circle HOLIDAY PROGRAMS allows the entire family to celebrate together in a comfortable setting. Innovative activities bring the warm and joyous feelings of the holiday to the children and their families.



#### **IVOLUNTEER**

iVolunteer is a new program allowing young adults, with and without disabilities, to gather in diverse settings to serve our community in various ways, such as serving food to the homeless, helping at local food banks, and bringing gifts to children in hospitals.



#### **SUNDAY CIRCLE**


# MITCHELL STEIN FELLOWSHIP AWARD






